SUBJECT: Authorize Sale of Declared Surplus Equipment

RECOMMENDATION: That the Board authorize the sale of declared surplus equipment as authorized at the February 16, 2007 Board meeting, to Bavarian Auto Recycling Inc., of Rancho Cordova, CA, in the amount of \$23,601.

DISCUSSION

At the February 2007 meeting, the Board declared several items surplus equipment, including a 1992 Ford F150 Pickup, a 1989 Chevy Pickup, a 924F Wheel Loader, and a Pressure Washer, all of which are currently non-operational. Staff estimated the value of these items to be \$15,500.

On May 24, 2007, bids were solicited from four qualified companies. Submitted bids were based on the entire list as no items were offered separately. The companies and their bids are as follows:

CONCLUSION

It is recommended that the Board accept the high bid of \$23,601 from Bavarian Auto Recycling, Inc. for the purchase of District surplus equipment. Upon Board authorization, Bavarian will have 30 days to remove the equipment from District property.
