

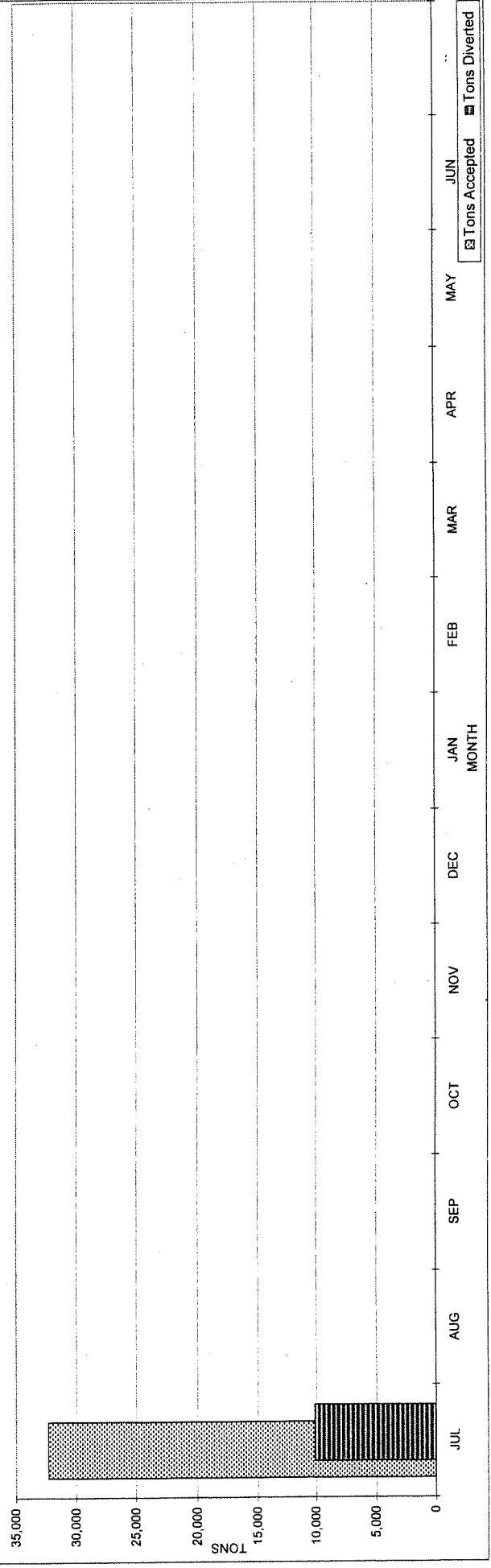

SOLID WASTE ACCEPTED TONNAGE - BY ORIGIN

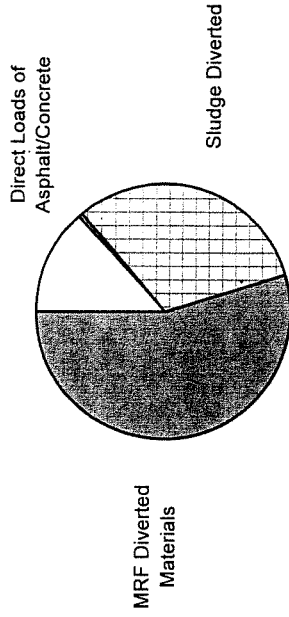

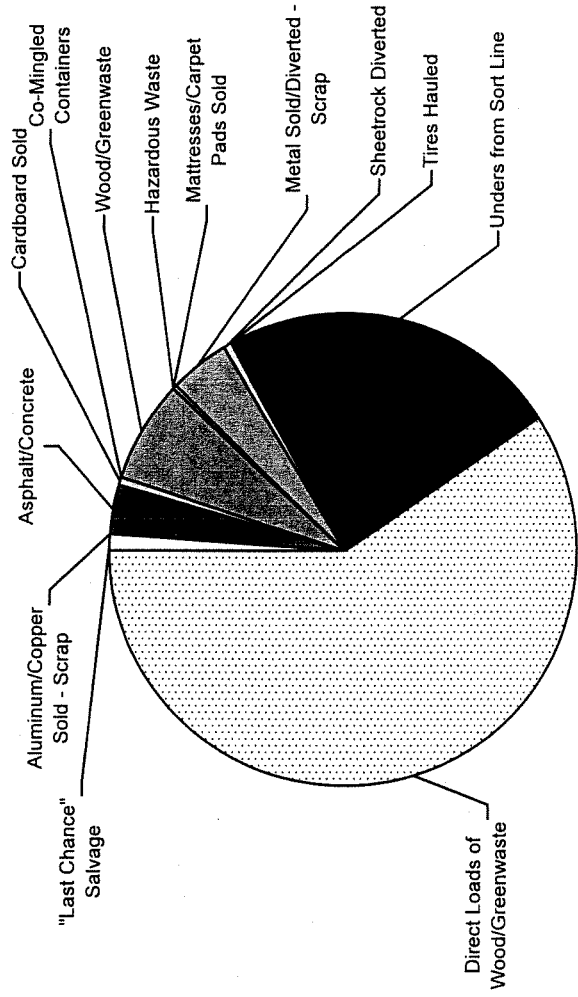
