SUBJECT: Purchase of Tink® Roll Out Bucket with JRB Coupler Device

RECOMMENDATION: That the Board of Directors authorize the purchase of a 7.75 CY Tink® Roll Out Bucket with JRB Coupler Device from Quinn Company of Salinas for a total price of \$33,703.30 (including sales tax and freight).

BACKGROUND

Funds in the amount of \$35,000 were included in the FY 08/09 Capital Outlay Budget for the purchase a "Tink" Roll Out Bucket used daily 8 to 10 hours per day for the moving and loading of wood products processed at the Material Recovery Facility. This bucket and coupler will replace the unit purchased in 2000, which has reached the end of its useful life due to metal fatigue resulting in more frequent downtime for repair. Continued high level of use required by this attachment could cause a serious failure and damage to District or customer equipment, or injury to a customer or employee.


REPORT OF BIDS

During the month of August 2008 staff requested quotes from two major local equipment suppliers to ensure lowest price for the specific equipment specified for use in the District's operation.

Vendor	Bid Price Total
Quinn Company of Salinas	\$33,703.30
Pape Machinery of Gilroy	\$35,178.00

CONCLUSION

The quotes were reviewed by staff and it was concluded that the low bid from Quinn Company meets and/or exceeds the specifications and best meets the needs of the District. Service will be provided by Quinn Company in Salinas and delivery will be within 60 days. It is therefore recommended that the Board authorize the purchase of the 7.75 CY Tink® Bucket with JRB Coupler Device from Quinn Company for a total price of \$33,703.30. Upon award of the quote and acceptance of the delivery of the new Tink® Bucket, staff will declare the existing bucket as surplus and attempt to sell it to the highest qualified bidder.
