This letter notifies you of the status of your application submitted under the Renewable Energy Production Incentive (REPI) Program for energy produced during fiscal year 2008. The facility's name is Landfill Power Plant-02 (Unit 2).

Your application was reviewed and approved. Your facility falls under the "40%" payment category, which, under the REPI program, means your facility uses a qualified renewable energy source other than solar, wind, ocean, geothermal or closed-loop biomass. The funding available for the current fiscal year is sufficient to make a pro rata payment for your net kWh generated/sold by your facility.

Under your current REPI application for this facility, a total of 7255695 kilowatt-hours qualify for payment. Congressional funding permits 1794544 kilowatt-hours to be reimbursed at the inflation adjusted payment rate of \$0.0207 per kilowatt-hour resulting in \$37.093 as your total incentive payment for fiscal year 2008. A recent records review of the REPI program has revealed that your facility is also eligible to receive \$ 2,540 for energy produced during fiscal year 2007 resulting in a total incentive payment of \$39.633. You should access the VIPERS website before September 15, 2009 in order to invoice the amount due your organization. Your CID code is MIGORE099.

Note: Your facility is eligible to receive REPI payments for ten consecutive fiscal years commencing with your facility's first REPI payment for fiscal year 2003. In addition, failure to file an application in any fiscal year for payment for energy generated in the preceding fiscal year shall disqualify the owner or operator from eligibility for any incentive payment for energy generated in that preceding fiscal year.

Your facility falls under the "40%" payment category, which, under the REPI program, means your facility uses a qualified renewable energy source other than solar, wind, ocean, geothermal or closed-loop biomass. The funding available for the current fiscal year is sufficient to make a pro rata payment for your net kWh generated/sold by your facility.

Under your current REPI application for this facility, a total of 12175026 kilowatt-hours qualify for payment. Congressional funding permits 3011237 kilowatt-hours to be reimbursed at the inflation adjusted payment rate of \$0.0207 per kilowatt-hour resulting in \$62,242 as your total incentive payment for fiscal year 2008. A recent records review of the REPI program has revealed that your facility is also eligible to receive \$ 5,917 for energy produced during fiscal year 2007 resulting in a total incentive payment of \$68,159.
