**SUBJECT: Call for Nominations for the Selection of One Regular LAFCO Commissioner (Due March 1, 2010)**

In accordance with your adopted procedures, I am writing to request nominations to fill the expiring term of one Regular Independent Special District representative on the Local Agency Formation Commission of Monterey County (LAFCO). **Please forward this letter to qualified candidates serving on your Board of Directors, and return their completed nomination papers (Attachments 1 and 2) to the LAFCO office by March 1, 2010.**

This Call for Nominations is to fill the Regular Member position now held by Tom Perkins, a Director of the King City Cemetery District. Commissioner Perkins has served as your representative for two terms, and will not seek re-election to LAFCO. This seat will expire in May. The other two Special District seats have terms that end in 2012. Those seats are filled by Don Champion, North County Fire Protection District (Regular Member) and Tom Moore, Marina Coast Water District (Alternate Member).

The Independent Special District Selection Committee is comprised of the presiding officer (Board Chair) or designee from each of the 43 independent special districts. The primary duty of the Selection Committee is to select three representatives to serve on LAFCO for four-year terms. The Selection Committee adopted its *Selection Process and Criteria* in 2002 (Attachment 3).

Pursuant to State law and the adopted criteria, any person qualified to serve as an Independent Special District representative to LAFCO may submit a nomination. Qualifications include board members of a legislative body of each of the 43 Independent Special District legislative bodies in Monterey County, located wholly within the County of Monterey, and those containing territory within the County representing 50% or more of the assessed value of taxable property of each district, but cannot include any members of a city or county legislative body.
