SUBJECT: Report on May 12, 2010 Monterey County Integrated Waste Management Task Force Meeting

Background

State law AB 939, the "California Integrated Waste Management Act (IWMA) of 1989, established an integrated waste management hierarchy to guide local agencies in implementation, in order of priority, of: (1) source reduction, (2) recycling and composting, and (3) environmentally safe transformation and land disposal. Additionally, the law requires each county to establish a task force to coordinate the development, monitoring and updates of Source Reduction and Recycling Elements and a countywide siting element.

The Monterey County Integrated Waste Management Task Force (MCIWMTF) consisting of local representatives from each city and the county, as well as the franchise haulers, and representatives appointed by the Board of Supervisors, met on May 12th at a meeting hosted by the City of Carmel-by-the-Sea. The MCIWMTF Chair is William Merry and the Vice Chair is Angela Brantley from the City of Monterey.


At the meeting, the MCIWMTF adopted new by-laws updating those first adopted some 20 years ago. The by-laws define who the members of the MCIWMTF are, the attendance required for a meeting quorum, etc. The Board of Supervisors will next receive the by-laws for approval, following which a copy will be provided to each city in the County requesting their ratification and the formal appointment of a representative from the jurisdiction to serve on the MCIWMTF. County staff anticipate that local jurisdictions should receive the by laws by July.

Items on the agenda included an update from staff from CalRecycle (formerly the California Integrated Waste Management Board). Concurrent with the 2009 annual AB 939 updates, which the District performs for each member agency, CalRecycle is implementing a new "Jurisdictional Review Tool" to serve as a comprehensive database of program information for each city and county. The State is requesting additional information this year on the efficiency of local recycling programs including:

- Participation Rates
- Set Out Rates
- Container Sizes
- Recover Rates
- How are Hauler Contracts Structured
- How is Program Effectiveness Tracked

The District will send an information request to local franchise haulers summarizing the information the State is asking local jurisdictions to provide. Other items of business at the meeting included discussion of the new mandatory C&D diversion requirements added to the State Building Code to take effect January 1, 2011, the role recycling and diversion assume in AB 32 program implementation, and the new Mandatory Recycling Ordinance adopted by the Salinas Valley Solid Waste Authority.

The next meeting of the MCIWMTF is scheduled for September 8th at 1:30 p.m. at Monterey County Environmental Health building.
