Electronic Waste

Computer monitors, televisions, cell phones, pagers and PDA's are accepted for recycling at the Last Chance Mercantile free of charge. It is against the law to dispose of electronic waste in the trash.

Recycling Drop-off Center

Our free drop-off recycling area accepts the following items:

- Mixed Paper including junk mail, phone books, letterhead, & cardboard
- Glass Bottles & Jars
- Plastic Bottles & Containers that contained food or liquid # 1-5 (remove lids, please) no Styrofoam
- Steel & Aluminum Cans, and most other metals including water heaters
- Appliances are accepted at the Materials Recovery Facility only

Household Hazardous Waste Collection

The District's HHW collection facility is open Monday-Saturday for convenient drop-off of hazardous materials. HHW includes alkaline batteries, paint, pesticides, motor oil, car batteries, pool chemicals, light bulbs, aerosols, acids, fuels, and caustics. California law prohibits the disposal of household hazardous waste in the trash.

Residents within the District service area may bring HHW for proper disposal free of charge.

Small Business Hazardous Waste Collection

Hazardous and regulated waste from small businesses such as fluorescent light bulbs, paint, cleaning chemicals, etc. is accepted by appointment only. Call 384-5313 to make an appointment or for more information. A small business processing fee applies.

All Loads are Subject to Hazardous Waste Load Checking

Hazardous and Other Prohibited Materials, as defined under California law and regulations, may not be disposed at the Monterey Peninsula Landfill or the Materials Recovery Facility. If hazardous materials are found in loads, the hauler is responsible for all costs associated with management of the hazardous material. In addition, the District may notify state and local regulatory agencies, and the responsible party or parties may be subject to civil or criminal prosecution, or both.

Monterey Regional Waste Management District Current Disposal Fees

Effective January 1, 2010

TYPE OF MATERIAL	PERTON	MIN CHARGE
SOLID WASTE (Basic Rate)	\$46.25	\$15
YARD WASTE AND WOOD WASTE <i>Unpainted wood and "clean green" yard waste only. No treated or painted wood, plywood, palm tree or fronds, ice-plant, cactus or poison oak. Sod may also be accepted at this rate.</i>	\$22.50	\$7
CLEAN CONCRETE/BRICK/ROCK	\$1	\$5
CLEAN OVERSIZED CONCRETE (or concrete w/rebar or pipe less than 8" exposed)	\$10	\$10
CLEAN ASPHALT	\$1	\$5
CLEAN MIXED LOADS OF CONCRETE AND ASPHALT	\$2	\$5
CLEAN LOADS OF SOIL	\$1	\$5

"Clean" means no garbage or debris mixed with load. Contaminated loads are charged at solid waste rate.

APPLIANCES, MATTRESSES AND ELECTRONIC WASTE

It is illegal to dispose of electronic waste items in the trash. They are accepted for recycling free at the Last Chance Mercantile. Deliver your TVs and monitors to the LCM before arriving at the scale. \$5/ea
