## Monterey Regional Waste Management District K-12 SCHOOL RECYCLING CONTAINER DONATION PROGRAM

### Eligible Schools

Public and private K-12 schools located within the MRWMD service area are eligible to request up to 8 free recycling containers. The MRWMD Service area includes: All coastal communities in Monterey County from Moss Landing to Big Sur, and schools in Carmel Valley, the Hwy. 68 corridor and Spreckles.

### School Authorization

Signed authorization is required from the school's principal. His or her support for new or expanded campus recycling programs is essential for recycling program success.

### Recycling Containers Available



#### **32 Gallon Blue Plastic Barrels\***

Barrels have a recycle symbol and lid with hole for beverage containers. This barrel is good for indoor and outdoor use (shown without lid.).



#### **Clear Streams\***

A foldable wire structure that holds a clear 55 gallon clear plastic bag for collection. Removable plastic lid has 3 openings for containers. Good for indoors and outdoors for temporary events.

### To Request Recycling Containers

- MRWMD will send an e-mail confirmation of your granted request within 5 days. You can then pick up your bins at the Last Chance Mercantile at MRWMD. (Hours: M-F, 8-5 & Sat. 8-4:30) In some cases MRWMD staff may be able to deliver the bins to your school.
- At the conclusion of the school year, we ask each school granted bins to report on recycling activities during the year and how the containers were used and helped in accomplishing your recycling goals. (Reporting form will be sent to you in advance.)
